childcare quality rating program.

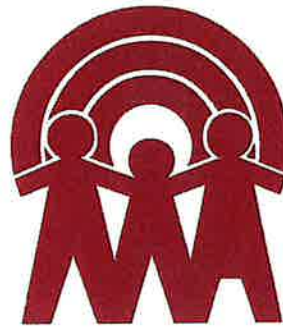
